saw her again.



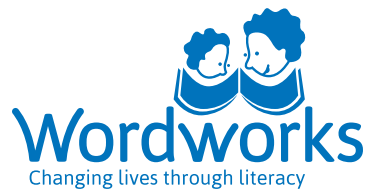
