





Harry the tadpole lived in a pond. He wished he could jump like a frog.



"Soon you will be able to jump like me," said his brother Freddy. "Look, your back legs have grown, and soon the front ones will grow too."




After a while Harry's front legs grew. "Can I jump now?" he asked. "Wait until your tail is much shorter," said Freddy.




One day a great big fish with sharp teeth wanted to eat Harry! Harry swam away as fast as he could.
