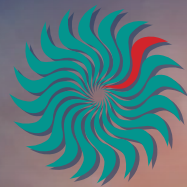




JET Education Services has 25 years in the business of education research, and has identified research capacity building as core to its sustainability strategy, which is also critical to South Africa at this stage in our development.

KEY OBJECTIVES

- ~ Build effective ready to work research capacity thereby bridging the gap from universities to the working world.
- ~ Understand whether the organisational development frameworks and current organisational structures for NGO/NPOs are fit for purpose in 21st century South Africa.
- ~ Generate knowledge products through research into various applications across the different levels of the education sector which will include reports, applications for devices, models of operation for the 21st century NGO and seminars/talks to collaborate, share and disseminate relevant knowledge defined, designed and tested during the 18 months of the first cohort.

OUTCOMES

- ~ Increased capability of individual researchers and organisations.
- ~ New or enhanced institutional frameworks; organizational structures & processes.
- ~ Functioning networks and collaboration between research organisations, training institutions, and partner NGOs.
- ~ Increased production and demand for effective research in education.



JET is excited about the possibility of building a steady stream of young black researchers that will flow into the NGO sector creating a basis for evidence-based and thoughtful interventions in education that our country desperately needs. It is our conviction that education needs to be reinvented in a way that talks much more directly to the societal and thus economic needs of the 21st century and that the engagement of young minds in this process is pivotal to bringing about change.

At the start of the programme JETStreamers undertake:
1 Full month induction
2 months workplace training at JET

3 MONTHS
May - August

15 MONTHS
September 2019 - October 2020

The second cohort is scheduled to begin in 2021/2022
